**Notice to Continuing Education Providers
Regarding Long Term Care Partnership Agent Training**

July 20, 2007

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department advises Pennsylvania continuing education providers and insurance producers of the training and education requirements of insurance producers that sell Long Term Care Partnership insurance policies. Act 40 of 2007 effective July 18, 2007 entitled the Long-Term Care Partnership Program requires all producers (resident and non-resident) licensed in Pennsylvania that will sell, solicit or negotiate long term care insurance **MUST** complete the "Pennsylvania Medicaid Long Term Care Services" course **BEFORE** they can market Long Term Care services.

To assist all producers with compliance with this new Long Term Care Services requirement, the Pennsylvania Insurance Department has created the course "Pennsylvania Medicaid Long Term Care Services" and is the **ONLY** course that will fulfill the requirement as outlined in Act 40. This course is approved for one (1) continuing education hour and will count towards the 24 hour CE requirement. This Long Term Care Partnership Agent training requirement is not in addition to the 24 hours of CE or required to be completed to renew an active resident license. However, this training is a prerequisite to selling, soliciting or negotiating long term care insurance in the state of Pennsylvania.

Any continuing education providers who wish to offer this course must attach the Pennsylvania approved course "Pennsylvania Medicaid Long Term Care Services" along with the appropriate course application and course fee to Prometric for review. The course content may be found on Prometric's web site at www.prometric.com under the Pennsylvania provider services section.

Please note the exam contains an asterisk behind the correct answer. The asterisk must be removed when presenting the course.

It is important to note, only the Pennsylvania Insurance Department developed course will be approved for the one hour requirement. If you submit a course that deviates from this course or contains different information it will be denied.
