C-42 Roofing Scope – Installation and repair of materials common to the industry that form a watertight, weather resistant surface for roofs and decks, including all accessories, flashing, valleys, gravel stops, and roof insulation panels above the roof deck. This scope includes all C-42R subclassifications.

L-42 Roofing Scope – Installation and repair of materials common to the industry that form a watertight, weather resistant surface for roofs and decks.

Included is sheet metal when installed in conjunction with a roofing project, application of protective and reflective roof and deck coatings, application of dampproofing or waterproofing, and installation of roof insulation panels and other roof insulation systems above roof deck.

The trade test is considered equivalent for these classifications and upon passing the CBME and trade exam, either license classification may be applied for without further testing.
