C-8 Floor Covering Scope – Installation and repair of floor covering materials and accessories. This scope includes all C-8R sub-classifications. Wood Flooring, Carpet, Composition Flooring, Non-Conventional Floor Cover, Ceramic and Clay Floor Covering.

L-8 Floor Covering Scope – Installation, replacement and repair of floor covering materials and related accessories including preparation of the surface to be covered. Included are linoleum, carpets, carpet backings and pads, and materials manufactured as asphalt, vinyl, vinyl asbestos, rubber, wood, ceramic and clay.

The trade test is considered equivalent for these classifications and upon passing the CBME and trade exam, either license classification may be applied for without further testing.
