- * -- Candidates taking the exam several times are counted only once.

- ² -- The "Overall" ratio is simply the ratio of the number of passes to the number of exams administered
- ³ -- The "Success" ratio is the percentage of candidates who passed the exam this quarter without regard to the number of attempts.
