Note: Because of the instability of pass ratios based on small numbers of administrations, pass ratios should not be interpreted for exams administered less than thirty times.

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- * -- Candidates taking the exam several times are counted only once.
- 1 -- The "First" ratio is the percentage of candidates who passed the examination the first time they took it.
- 2 -- The "Overall" ratio is simply the ratio of the number of passes to the number of exams administered
- 3 -- The "Success" ratio is the percentage of candidates who passed the exam this quarter without regard to the number of attempts.
