Scope – Installation and repair of approved types of fire prevention and fire protection systems including all mechanical apparatus, devices, piping, low voltage signaling systems, and equipment common to the industry. Installation of all other electrical devices, apparatus and wiring must be subcontracted to a properly licensed contractor. The scope includes the C-16R subclassification.
