

Following a recent examination review workshop (ERW) Michigan Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation (OFIR) has determined that the Michigan Life and Variable Annuities (16-84) Producer combination licensing examination requires an update in content to adequately test for minimum entry level competence. Therefore, beginning December 9, 2010, all candidates for licensure as Life and Variable Annuities producers will be required to take the Life (16-65) and Variable Annuities (16-83) licensing examinations separately. Candidates will be allowed to take the combination examination (16-84) through December 8, 2010.

As of December 9, 2010, the Life and Variable Annuities (16-84) combination examination will not be offered while the examination content is under redevelopment. Candidates will be required to take the Life (16-65) and Variable Annuities (16-83) licensing examinations separately.
